The program will include Barber's Adagio for Strings, Ralph Vaughan Williams' English Folk Song Suite, and much more, led by Music Director Lawrence Loh.

Founded 64 years ago, the Pittsburgh Youth Symphony Orchestra is currently comprised of 90 of the most talented and accomplished young musicians in the tri-state area that come from over 30 school districts, colleges, and universities throughout the tri-state area. PYSO was chosen twice through competitive auditions to be one of a small group of orchestras in the United States chosen to attend the American Symphony Orchestra League's National Youth Orchestra Festivals in 1998 and 2002. PYSO has also participated in international youth orchestra festivals in Canada, Scotland and Switzerland, frequently winning first place awards for outstanding performances. PYSO completed a successful European Concert Tour in June 2005 and undertook a two-week tour of China in June 2008, presenting concerts in Beijing, Shanghai, Hangzhou, and Hong Kong. A concert tour of Italy is being planned for 2011.
